The Republican Party of Florida (RPOF) and Republican National Committee (RNC) Have Lost its Exclusive Rights to the GOP Federal Trademark. (Letter Number 6)

Dear Mr. LaCivita:

In a landmark decision, the RPOF's complaint against Manuel P. Asensio, the St. Johns Republican Presidential Executive Committee, and the domain names stjohs.org has been **DISMISSED**.

The Decision is based on a full review and consideration of the facts, factors, and circumstances, and a legal analysis. Since the Decision and Order was in our favor, John Hammond's conduct was not adjudicated. The Panel directed us to resolve our dispute "in another forum where discovery and cross-examination would be available to more fully assess the merits." Our dispute concerns the regulation of organized federal judicial corruption at the US Judicial Conference and its presiding officer, John Roberts.

The best forum is between us and President Donald J. Trump. Trump is the GOP's presidential candidate. Our information undermines things Leonard Leo and Bill Barr have provided to President Trump. It abrogates any legitimacy that has been provided to J. Mike Luttig's directives to VP Mike Pence. Please advise President Trump that I have reached out to Stephen Miller and Mike Davis, and that I am available to meet with them at any time.
